APPLICATION FOR SEARCH OF DEATH RECORD FILES

The Perry County Clerk's office provides certified official copies of death records from originals on file in the office. The fee for a certified copy of a birth record is \$12. Additional copies of the same record purchased at the same time are \$4 each. Certified copies bear the County Clerk's signature and a raised seal. They are acceptable for all legal purposes.

Genealogical copies of death records are available only for records on file for more than 20 years. Genealogical copies are \$3 each. Genealogical copies are issued on plain paper and are clearly marked "For Genealogical Purposes Only." These copies are not certified and not acceptable for legal purposes.

ELIGIBILITY FOR DEATH RECORD



Before request for a certified or uncertified copy can be considered, you must specify your eligibility to obtain it. Illinois law states that certifications or certified copies of birth records may be issued only as listed below:

Upon the specific written request for a certified or uncertified copy by the person, or his duly authorized agent, having a genealogical (record must be over 20 years old), personal or property right interest in the record.

If you are eligible, please indicate on the application your relationship to the person registered and the intended use of the copy. Return the application to the Perry County Clerk's Office with the proper fee or receipt showing you have already paid the fee.
